

JIM MCCULLOCH



A founder member of Glasgow Indie heroes **The Soup Dragons** and the **BMX Bandits**, guitarist **Jim McCulloch** has been involved in the music business for over 30 years. From Glasgow's seminal C-86 indie scene to cutting edge folk/rock in 2020, Jim has been writing songs for over 15 years and has released 3 solo albums under the name Green Peppers released on Glasgow's Neon Tetra label.

These days, with singer/songwriter Anna Sheard, is the creative powerhouse behind folk/rock newcomers Snowgoose, whose second album *The Making of You*, released on Glass Modern, was one of Scotland's most significant album releases of 2020.

Jim has also lent his songwriting skills to other artists, most notably singer Isobel Campbell and her 3 collaborative albums with American singer Mark Lanegan. Jim contributed material and collaborated on the Mercury Prize-nominated *Ballad of the Broken Seas*, *Sunday At Devil Dirt* and *Hawk*. He has also contributed songs to her solo album releases as well. Highlights include “You Won't Let Me Down Again”, “Salvation” and “It's Hard to Kill A Bad Thing”, which tap into a dark, rich vein of American Blues and equally informed by English folk music, albeit from a uniquely Glaswegian perspective.

Never one for resting on his laurels, expect new music from Jim McCulloch in 2021.
